



**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE
PREPARATION OF THE PAPER FOR
THE SCIENTIFIC-TECHNICAL AND
INFORMATION MAGAZINE
"TRANSPORT, CONSTRUCTION &
ENGINEERING"**

***Abstract:** Instruction for the preparation of the papers for the magazine "Transport, Construction & Engineering" is presented. These pages provide You with an example of the layout and style, which we wish You to adopt during the preparation of Your paper.*

Please, make an abstract as short as possible summarizing the paper in max 250-300 words, but including sufficient detail to permit a reasonable evaluation.

***Key words:** up to six words*

1. INTRODUCTION

This is an instruction for the preparation of the paper for the magazine "Transport, Construction & Engineering", which is publishing three times of year from the *Association by mechanical, civil and transport engineering*.

The publication is publishing in English.

2. FORMAT

The text should be written on page A4 format (210 x 297) using fonts Times New Roman, 10 pt, single spacing, two columns (5 mm between columns). Margins: top, bottom - 20 mm, inside - 25 mm, outside - 15 mm, using mirror margins.

Paper should not exceed 4 or max 6 pages.

2.1. Title

The title of the paper should be written with capital letters, 12 point, bold. Leave one blank line (10 point) and write authors' first name (10 point, bold) and last name (10 point, bold, capital letters).

The paper should be prepared according to the explanations provided in Table 1.

Table 1. Editorial instructions

No	Item	Explanation
1.	Paper size	Use A4 format (210 x 297).
2.	Length	Regular papers should have max 6 pages.
3.	Margins	Use mirror margins, and leave 20 mm as margins at the top and the bottom, 25 mm on inside and 15 mm as outside margins.
4.	Page Layout	The main body of the text should be written in two columns, each left and right justified. The width of column is 82.5 mm and spacing between columns is 5 mm.
5.	Fonts	The 10 point Times Roman font in 1.0 line spacing is recommended.

2.2. Abstract

After two blank lines write "Abstract:" – bold, italic and in the same line continue with text of abstract (italic), not to exceed 10 lines.

Skip one line and write "Key words:" – bold, italic and in the same line write max five key words - italic.

2.3. Style

After two blank lines write section headings (11 points, bold, capital letters), subsection headings and sub-subsection headings (11 points, bold), left justified. Before and after section headings use 10 point space and before and after subsection and sub-subsection headings use 5 point space.

Inserted picture and diagrams should have a good quality and resolution at least 300 dpi.

At the end, leave two blank lines and write heading "References" (11 points, bold, capital letters). Please follow the instructions for each type of references, given on the next page.

At the very end of the paper, write "Correspondence" (11 points, bold, capital letters) with author's first name (10 point), last name (10 point, capital letters), title and scientific degree, name of the institution, address for correspondence and e-mail address.

When sending paper, please, send the pictures of the author and coauthors in JPEG or TIFF format (resolution at least 300 dpi). If You won't, we'll resize them and insert in the paper beside the correspondence address.

3. TABLES AND FIGURES

3.1. Tables

Tables should be presented in the form shown in Table 1 of this instruction. The title of the table should be

numbered and written above the table (10 point, italic). Before table title use 10 point space and after table title use 5 point space. If a table is too wide to fit into one column (82.5 mm), You can put it in one pagewidth column (170 mm). If a table is too long to fit into one page, the table number and headings should be repeated on the next page before the table is continued. Alternatively, the table can be spread over two consecutive pages turned 90° without repeating the headings.

3.2. Figures

The title of the figure should be numbered and written below the figure (10 point, centered, italic). Before and after figure title use 10 point space. All figures should be clearly displayed by leaving single line of spacing above and below them. All notations and lettering should be no less than 2 mm high. The use of heavy black, bold lettering should be avoided as they will look unpleasantly dark when printed. Pictures should be inserted in the paper as JPEG or TIFF format (resolution at least 300 dpi).

4. EQUATIONS

Equations should be placed flush- left with the text margin and should be preceded and followed by one blank line (5 point).

$$(1) \quad S(t) = \lambda \cdot d^3 - \sum_{i=1}^f s_i$$

If they are numbered make sure that they are numbered consequently. Put the numbers in parentheses flush with the right- hand margin level with the last line of the equation.
